PENSION AND WELFARE

The Pension/ Welfare Officer is the first person a Veteran will contact when they require advice or assistance.

Our Pension/Welfare Officers are trained under the Department of Veterans' Affairs TIP Training Scheme and must update their training every three years.

PENSION OFFICE

Services include

- Assessment and assistance to understand your pension entitlements.
- Assistance and advice in the preparation of initial disability claims and lodgment with the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- Assistance and advice with the upgrade of an existing Disability Pension.
- Advice and assistance with appeals against any Departmental decisions.
- Assist with any other Pension related matters.
- Strict confidentiality applies.

WAR OR DEFENCE WIDOW/ERS PENSION

(Not all that glitters is gold)

The widow/er must have been legally married to or partner of an eligible person immediately before death of eligible person. The Gold Card is not an automatic step to a widow/ers pension. The eligible person must have

- Died as a result of injury or disease which is accepted as war or defence caused
 - Had death determined as war or defence caused
 - Been in receipt of a disability pension at Special Rate (TPI)
 - Been in receipt of an EDA Pension (Extreme Disability Allowance)
 - Been a former Australian Prisoner of War
- Or
- Been in receipt of a Section 27 Allowance as a double amputee

Please read these points carefully and check your

Gold Card and if it does not have TPI, EDA or POW in the bottom left hand corner it may be worth seeing a Pension Officer to check your entitlements. Advice costs nothing
